not too big, but not too small

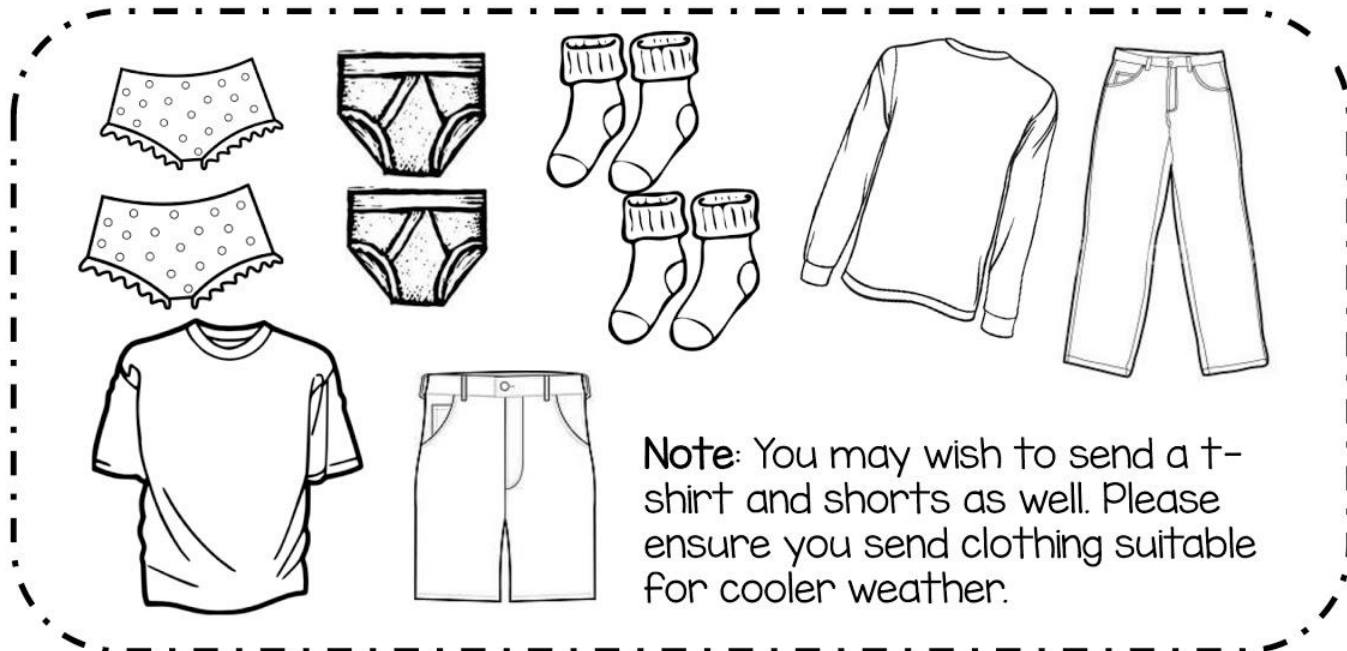

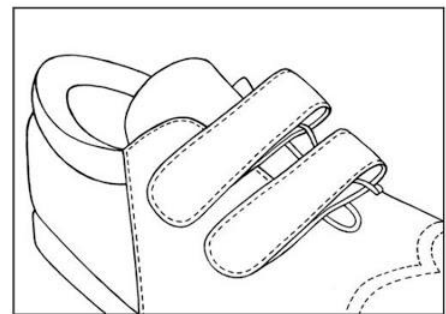

Also, splash and snow pants, shoes and boots often look similar and young children have difficulty identifying their own items.
